and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as classed without fresh record of dry docking, subject to permanent repairs to shell frames and tank top plating in cargo holds being carried out by completion of the Special Survey on the ship's arrival at the Greek Port to which she is now proceeding, and to any other conditions of class at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.
