Dear Sir,

'EVER HAPPINESS'

With reference to your cable of 21st June '65, I have to advise that a general examination of the hull and machinery and the equipment of the vessel was carried out on 25.6.65 and subsequently, in accordance with the Instructions to Surveyors Part 3a 1963 for vessels which are over 14 years old and Part 3b for machinery.

The after peak tank and the structure in the double bottom immediately forward and aft of the machinery could not be examined at the time as these were stated to be full of fresh water and fuel oil respectively. As loading was commenced immediately on the vessel's arrival here on 23.6.65, it was not possible to examine the tank tops in the holds immediately below the hatches.

Since the actual date of the new LLST to be issued here, was not mentioned in your cable it was not clear whether the vessel was to be placed for special survey at the beginning of August or end of it. A copy of the cable from the owners to the local agents, forwarded to me along with the request for survey stated 31st August as the date of expiry. I have therefore issued the new LLST to expire on 30.8.65 which still allows the vessel to be placed for survey in August. I trust this meets with your approval.
