More than 10% of the total were tested by water pressure to 1,500 lbs/sq. inch and found satisfactory.

20 Mild Steel Superheater Headers reconditioned and tested to 660 lbs W.P. for working pressure of 220 lbs/sq.inch.

The Headers and elements are, so far as can be seen, sound and free from defects.
