This will acknowledge your letter of the 3rd instant in respect to the Screwshaft survey which became due in May last.

The vessel is now laid up and her machinery is being opened up for survey when the Crankshaft will be given a further examination, together with other parts of the main and auxiliary machinery.

The vessel up to the end of December, 1955, operated a ferry service between Portugal Cove, C.B. and Wabana, Bell Island, Nfld., but her Owners have now withdrawn her from this service and at present are not in a position to say what will be done with her. However, before going into operation it is their intention to have her drydocked and all outstanding items dealt with.

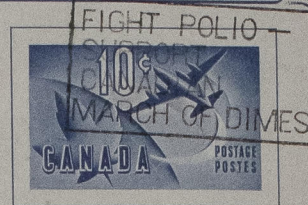
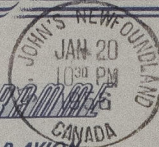
