
TEMPORARY ALTERATIONS:-

Two - 18" dia. vent coamings, (1 P. & 1 S. side at after end of No.2 Hold) and

Two - 18" dia. vent coamings, (1 P. & 1 S. side at forward end of No.3 Hold).

on upper deck cut approximately 8" above deck and efficiently blanked with
electrically welded plates.

This was done to allow stowage of railway cars on deck and are to be refitted
at Owners' convenience.

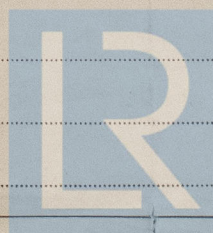
