The Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a report from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe in regard to this ship, from which it is noted they recommend that a full Machinery Survey should be carried out, together with permanent repairs to the main turbines, complete re-tubing of the starboard boiler, and renewal of the economiser tubes of the port boiler.

It is understood that the vessel is at present laid up and that you are considering the possibility of fitting a new heavy oil engine, but in view of the condition of the machinery, as now reported, and the fact that the Special Survey became due so long ago as June, 1953, the Committee have decided to qualify the class of this ship with a notation of "Laid up pending machinery repairs and surveys overdue".
