I have to thank you for your letter of the 7th instant, regarding the above Vessel and have to say that the Classification Certificates have been handed over to the Owners' Representatives, Messrs. G. T. R. Campbell, with an explanation of the circumstances of the omission of the distinguishing 'cross' in the Machinery notation.

I have today also explained to Mr. C. S. Allin, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Andros Shipping Company, the reasons for the omission of the distinguishing 'cross', the circumstances which he fully appreciates but the reaction to which he would express no opinion.
