I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th January with data sheet and specification in quadruplicate relating to the above and in reply have the pleasure to inform you that the refrigerating machinery specification for this vessel could be approved for the required temperature (-50°) for U.K. - Near Continent Services only, provided the arrangements be as shown, additional spare gear be provided as shown in red in the specification, and the remaining requirements of the Society's Rules for Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances be complied with so far as they are applicable. One copy of the specification is returned herewith.

It is understood from the Owners, however, that No. 2 Hold is to be insulated instead of No.1 Hold, and perhaps you will kindly advise me as to the amendments which should be made in the specification and data sheet, particularly with regard to alterations in the exposed surface and heat leakage.

Further, I shall be pleased if you will be good enough to submit the following drawings at your earliest convenience:-
