Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that a freeboard report has been received from the Society's Surveyor at Bergen, respecting the Steamer "TELA", and to say that Convention ordinary and timber deck cargo freeboards have been computed on the basis of the information supplied thereon. The freeboard report and computations are enclosed herewith, together with the Norwegian certificate and three copies.

You should issue the certificate to the Owners when the alterations required to satisfy the Norwegian Authorities have been completed and the freeboards marked on the ship's sides. One copy of the certificate should also be sent to the Owners, one to the Norwegian Authorities and one retained in your Office for record purposes.

I shall be glad if you will be good enough to insert the dates of issue and expiry in the certificates.

When this case has been completed you will be so good as to return to this Office the freeboard reports and to forward details of the alterations effected together with a memorandum or particulars entered in the freeboard certificates.
