m.s. "RIVERGATE" & "FRIARGATE"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th March with enclosure and have to request that you will advise the Owners that there is no record in this Office regarding the receipt of their original letter of the 3rd December.

It is noted they desire to withdraw these ships from classification when the next survey is due, and as the Screwshaft Survey of the "RIVERGATE" becomes due next month it is proposed to submit this case to the Committee for withdrawal of class at the end of April.

In the case of the "FRIARGATE" the limit on the ahead pinion and ahead clutch assembly of the main engine reverse reduction gearing expires at the end of this month, and the Owners' request will therefore be submitted to the Committee at the beginning of April.

It is concluded these arrangements will meet the Owners' requirements.
