It should be pointed out however, that in addition to the above, the following items also require to be examined for the completion of the General Examination:-

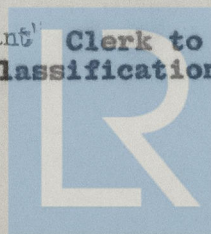
Fore and aft peak tanks.
