In reply to your letter of the 25th. inst. regarding extracts from a Classing Letter received from Wokingham regarding the above, the following information is forwarded:-

"The thickness of the 10"X3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bulb angle bulkhead stiffeners in each Vessel is .52" ✓  
The thickness of the bottom strake of plating of the after peak bulkhead is 7/16" as in the "Willow Park". ✓  
The length of the forecastle in accordance with Circular 1551 is 33'-8". ✓  
The thickness of the Upper deck plating within the line of opening in each case is 5/16-3/8". ✓

Attention will be given, in future Reports regarding the last paragraph of your letter.
