The CARDIFF Surveyors report Vessel afloat and on account of heavy weather starboard side hawsepipe, as above, renewed, and (buckled) side plating (ss) in way of flange of hawse pipe dealt with.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Vessel is eligible to remain as classed subject to solepiece of sternframe (E.W. and reinforced 9,48 and previously) to permanent repairs to shell plates Nos.5 in 2nd,3rd and 4th strakes below sheer (ss) at the next drydocking, and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity, but without other conditions.
