We thank you for your letter of the 14th of October 1965, R, and beg to confirm that the position of this Ship remains unchanged.

With reference to the second paragraph of your letter we beg to advise you that only one visit was made to the Ship by Mr. Phillip, no repairs/alterations were commenced due to the Indonesian Owner being unable to obtain an allocation of foreign exchange from the Indonesian Government.

Mr. Phillip's (who is now in Spain) Journal entry for the 4th of October 1962 reads as follows:-

" Examined all decks, and recommended test holes in all decks, tank tops, bulkheads, frames, margin plates, bilge brackets,....., etc: Vessel generally in poor condition and will require much renewal."
