This vessel was classed in June 1917, subject to the inner surface of the bottom plating, which is coated with tar & cement, being examined within six months from that time.

The Owners now state that the vessel has been taken over by the Government and is on important service in the North of Scotland, and under these circumstances they will be glad if the Committee will postpone the examination required until a more favourable opportunity.

In the circumstances, it is submitted action might be deferred for the present.
