I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st March, with its enclosures.

Due to the Owners' extras in this ship, the proposed increase in length will not involve increases to the scantlings at present fitted. The equipment, however, will require to be increased, the kedg anchor being made $4\frac{3}{4}$ cwts., the stream anchor $1\frac{1}{4}$ cwts. ex stock and 90 fathoms of $7/8$ " cable being supplied.

I assume that new plans and freeboard particulars will be submitted if the proposal is to be proceeded with.
