Dimensions 97'10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20'10" x 10'-1"

We propose to increase the length of the above vessel by 9'10 $\frac{1}{2}$ "; this will be done by adding six frame spaces at midships. The spacing of the frames at midship is 1'-7 $\frac{3}{4}$ ". We estimate that the moulded draft will be 9'-0 $\frac{7}{8}$ ", a reduction of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

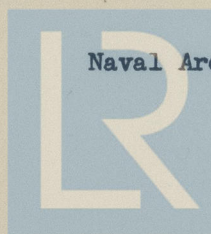
We propose to make the scantling of the new part similar to the present scantlings.

We enclose a statement giving the revised Equipment Numeral. We propose to use the same equipment, as some items were above rule to satisfy Owners' requirements.
