the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Donkin & Co. Limited, attend at their Works at Walker-gate, Newcastle upon Tyne, on the 30th March, 1951 and subsequently, for the purpose of examining and testing :-

One Electric Motor Driven 2 Ram Hydraulic  
Steering Gear No. 8943 (Works Order No.8453)

intended for Messrs. Rotterdam Dockyard Co., Rotterdam, Holland, their Ship s.s. "CITY OF LONDON".

The hydraulic cylinders were subjected to a water test of 2000 lbs. per square inch with satisfactory results. The rams are solid cast iron.

The Cast Steel Tiller L.R.370-6, J.H.J. 21-3-51, the Cast Steel Trunnion L.R.3794 J.H.J. 30-3-51 and Cast Steel Keep L.R. 380-1 J.H.J. 21-3-51 were examined after machining and found satisfactory.

On completion the hydraulic steering gear was examined under running conditions (no load) and its operation was found satisfactory.

The electric motor No. F.272A3344 made by Messrs. Crompton Parkinson Ltd. drives Donkin Pump No. PF.1421.

So far as could be seen, the materials and workmanship are good.
