I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for conversion from open to closed shelterdecker.

Now done:

1. The tonnage hatch was closed watertight by stiffened steel cover secured by hookbolts, provided with rubber packing.
2. Overboard scuppers from tonnage well closed.
3. The loadlines appropriate to the closed condition marked and verified and the previous loadlines obliterated.
4. Loadline items generally found good.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking.
