60636 "GUANG HING". This ship has today been classed #100 A.1 "Strengthened for Heavy Cargoes" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

With regard to the main engine bedplate, I shall be glad if you will state whether the vertical welds of the tie rod boxes in the transverse girders and the welds connecting vertical brackets to inclined longitudinal members abreast transverse girders are of fillet or full penetration weld.
