I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

This vessel surveyed in dry dock in conjunction with Occasional survey.

No alterations have taken place in the hull or superstructures which will affect the Freeboard calculations.

REPAIRS:- 12 hatch covers renewed, and 22 hatch covers repaired. All Freeing Ports made workable.

Certificate and copy endorsed:- "The provisions of the Convention being fully complied with by this vessel, the certificate is renewed till 28th February 1939.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 8401 dated 16th September 1935. which ~~is returned herewith~~ will be returned.
