No material alterations have been made which affect the calculation of freeboard.

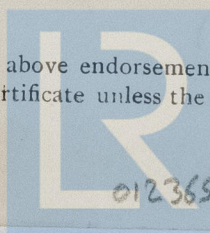
The nature of the closing appliances has been checked with the certificate, and these found in order.
