Steamer "GUDMUNDUR JUNI"

I duly received your letter of the 27th August and, in view of the information furnished by you, the case has been reported to the Committee today.

The Committee conclude that the ship is still laid up at your port and, bearing in mind that the year of grace for the Special Survey has now expired, they have decided to follow the normal procedure and insert in the Register Book against this ship's name the notation "Surveys overdue (8.59)".

In informing the Owners of this decision you should remind them that once the overdue surveys have been held this notation will be deleted from the Register Book.

It is noted that it has been decided to convert this ship from a steam trawler to a motor cargo ship and I think it well to remind you that plans of the proposed alterations, both hull and machinery, should be forwarded to this office for approval before the work is commenced.
