Steam Ships " GUEMUNDUR JUNI " and " GYLLIR "

With reference to your letter of 27th ultimo and cable to day regarding the above vessels .

" GUEMUNDUR JUNI " I was informed yesterday , by the new Owners of this ship , that it has been decided to convert her , from steam trawler to a motor cargo ship and I will be sending to the Society , for approval , drawings of the alterations when completed .

" GYLLIR " The General Examination for postponement of Special Survey for 3 months and Boiler Survey have been dealt with , and the vessel sailed from Reykjavik some days ago loaded with scrap iron to a continental port , and that will be her only and last voyage , she will be broken up at GENT on completion of unloading , according to informations from the Owners .
