Trawlers "GYLLIR" and "GUDMUNDUR JUNI"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant and have today submitted to the Committee the question raised by you.

In reply I am asked to say that, before the trawler "GYLLIR" undertakes the contemplated voyages from Iceland to the Continent, loaded with scrap iron, the following requirements must be met:-

1. The General Examination, apparently already started, must be completed.
2. If cargo is to be carried, it is necessary for a Load Line to be assigned and this may necessitate some alterations to the closing appliances.

On satisfactory completion of the above work the class of LOOAL "Trawler" could be amended and Certificates issued valid for a period of three months.
