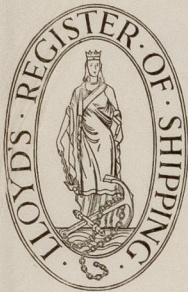

recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have Recommended that she be retained as classed

without fresh record of survey subject to shell plating,

stern frame and rudder being specially examined and dealt with

as necessary on the next occasion in drydocking (due May 1956.)
