I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo referring to Alexandria Report No.4812 on the above vessel.

I am of the opinion that it will not be necessary to specially examine the turbines of the vessel until the next Special Survey. For your information I would add that this particular vessel is used as a Pilgrim ship and normally operates for only three months in the year, during the Pilgrim Season, also it is the practice of the Owners in any case to open up the turbines at about two yearly intervals when opportunity is afforded to the Surveyor for examination of same.
