Dear Sir,

On the 24th instant the steamer "GERDA TOFT" of Copenhagen was lost, with all her crew, in the North Sea.

The Owners state that a legal inquiry will be held at Copenhagen one of the first days in January, 1955 and they have asked to have copies of the interim certificates issued when the vessel was under survey at Elsinore in June, 1954.

The survey in question was held at Elsinore during the days loth to 21st June, 1954 and the Report has No. 14781.

A later survey was held at Copenhagen in August, 1954, and the Report has No. 14855.

Interim certificates have not been issued in either of the above cases and the Owners will therefore be pleased to have photostatic copies of the above Reports.

The matter has been discussed in this office and it has been suggested that, in addition to the above, interim certificates could be issued. They should have the present date but otherwise appear as they would have if they had been issued at the time of writing the Report.
