In reply to your Classing Letter dated 31st March last, regarding the Weld Test Reports of the Boiler Shells, we have to say that, in checking through our test records, we find tests representing Boiler Shells were inadvertently identified with Boiler Heads and vice versa.

When these Reports were made, a considerable number of Weld Tests for Boiler Shells and Heads were being made for Welded and Riveted Boilers building for Dominion Bridge Company, Vancouver, B.C. and Canadian Vickers Ltd., Montreal and we regret that these errors were not discovered before the Reports were sent out.

We herewith enclose amended photoshat copies of Boiler Shell Reports for the undermentioned Boilers, and we shall be obliged if you will kindly disregard those already sent and substitute the enclosed.
