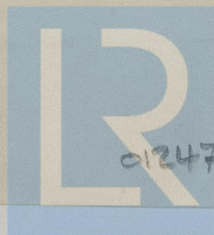
It was stated that the outstanding surveys would be carried out before the vessel was put into Service either by the Government or the Owners and that we would be advised soon as a decision was made in this matter.
