I acknowledge your letter of the 13th December and have arranged for this case again to receive the consideration of the Committee today in the light of the appeal which has been made to you by the Owners. As it is understood this ship has been requisitioned by the Pakistan Government for some considerable time, it is concluded the appeal came from them and not from the actual owners of the vessel.

The Committee have carefully reviewed the whole position in the light of the latest information but do not consider they would be justified in maintaining this ship's class for a voyage from Khulna to Karachi, bearing in mind that she has not been seen in drydock since February 1956.

They have therefore decided to adhere to their previous decision and to maintain the notation of "Surveys overdue - Class suspended 11,58." which has already been assigned.
