The case of the above named vessel has received further consideration by the Committee today in the light of your cablegram of the 2nd instant, reading as follows:-

"REURCAB TWENTYFIRST FIRISHTA PRINCIPAL OFFICER CHITTAGONG INFORMS DUE SAIL THIS WEEK DESIRES ADVICE REGARDING CLASS"

In confirmation of my reply as per copy herewith, I am instructed by the Committee to say that in the circumstances they are agreeable to maintenance of class for the proposed voyage, but the Mercantile Marine Government of East Pakistan must be informed that all overdue surveys must be in hand by the end of February, otherwise the vessel's class will be expunged without further notice.
