Requirements for Annual Load Line Survey were discussed with the Master and Government of East Pakistan representative in Calcutta. This survey will be held in due course.

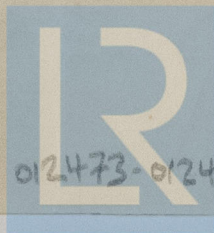
