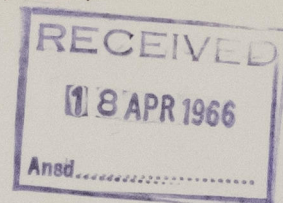


We enclose a copy of a letter from the Owners of the above ship in which it will be noted that they wish to re classify this ship with the Society.

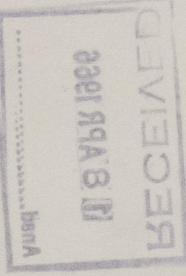
