With reference to Ipswich Reports Nos.107023,
S. 107024 and 107054 on Messrs. Davey, Paxman & Co.'s Engines
Nos.50024/5 and Generator Sets Nos. 1174/5, I may say that
a report has come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at
Greenock, from which it appears that these engines have been
satisfactorily fitted on board the Motorship "BARIMA", which
vessel has been classed ~~RA1~~ For River & Coastal Service, British
Guiana, with notations of Lloyd's A & C P, ~~ELMC~~ 5,39 Oil Eng.

It is concluded that a spare lubricating oil pump
has been fitted, as in the cases of the sister ships "POMEROON"
and "LADY NORTHCOTE", but I shall be glad if you will kindly
confirm this.
