


"STECKENPFERD" ex "SKIPSEA"

This ship was built in 1936 at Messrs. William Doxford & Sons Ltd., Yard No. 628, and is one of a series of sister ships. Mr. Dirk Auer of the Verolme United Shipyards (London) Ltd., has called at this office and handed in 8 plans which he has obtained from the Builders and which he states the Owners would like to have approved and stamped with the official die stamp.

It is seen that these are working drawings and it is, therefore, not possible to approve them in toto. The plan of midship section has, however been compared with the original approved plan and the First Entry Report of the series, and it is found that the main scantlings are in accordance therewith. Mr. Auer has been advised of the above over the telephone and he states that in the circumstances he would like to have a letter to this effect in order that it may be transmitted to the Owners.

IT IS SUBMITTED this be done and the plans returned to him.
