IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the Surveyors be advised it is concluded that 30 fathoms of 4" sisal hawser has been supplied but this should be confirmed. They should also be requested to furnish a copy of Midship Section and Profile & Decks plans (or "Framing & Keelsons" plan) showing the ship as built as per "Instructions to Surveyors, para 26 p.18.

The Rangoon Surveyor should be requested to carry out a General Examination of the ship in drydock on its arrival there and when the ceiling in the hold spaces has been laid and fitting out for service completed, furnish a Rpt.8 on the case.
