Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in MARCH, 1932.

The coaling hatches in the bridge tween decks have now been altered as under:

The 9' x 4' hatch (port) has been removed and deck in way plated over.
" " " " (stbd.) " " reduced in size to 4' x 3'

There are also 2-4'6" x 3' coaling hatches (1 port and 1 stbd.) abreast the fore end of the boiler casing.

All the above have efficient battening arrangements.

New ventilators have been cut as follows:

On casing top:- 1 @ 18" diam. coaming 4'0" x 3/16" to engine room

The engine skylight on casing top: 1 @ 18" diam. coaming 3'3" x 3/16 to engine room

" " " " " " 1 @ 42" " " 4'0" x 3/16 " "


The 6 14"-18" vents on f'cle bridge deck should read 4 @ 14"-18"

" 2 28" " " " " " " 4 @ 28"

" 5 24" " " poop deck should read 4 @ 24" to holds, and 1 @ 16" dia. to tunnel.

There are also 2 @ 6" dia. vents in f'cle bridge deck to engine room.
