In reply to your cablegram of the 17th February, I am pleased to inform you that provided a satisfactory General Examination of the hull and machinery, including the testing of the bilge suction, is held when the Special Survey is commenced at Colombo about the 22nd February, the Committee will then be prepared to consider the postponement of the completion of the Special Survey.

In this connection, I have to say that, in view of our experience with ships more than 20 years old, the Committee are prepared to agree to postponement of Special Surveys only after a very thorough General Examination of the hull has been held, including an internal examination of any water ballast deep tanks. The period of postponement is dependent upon the condition of the ship as found at the General Examination.

The next Steampipe Survey will require to be held by the completion of the Special Survey.
