Recommended: Permanent repairs to shell damage starboard side aft (Contact with Haringvlietbrug 23-12-65) viz Sheerstrake plate no. 3 and 1st below no. 4 to be renewed.

Framing and bulwark plating & C to be dealt with as found necessary.

Several scored shell rivets port side in way of D2-3 to be dealt with.

Further recommended rudder to be rebushed, chains and blocks & C of steering gear to be cleaned and opened for examination.

Noted starboard side bilge strake amidships D3 locally indented (blemish)
