

Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 12th September, 1966 we beg to inform you that from contacts with the Owners we learned that the contract of purchase will be signed some time this week or next week.

The Owners will be advisers of the new Owners and we understood that upon arrival of the ship at this port shortly, she will be drydocked, propeller and tailshaft removed and the sterntube as well as a number of other openings in the ship closed up and the shell protected by a special coating.

It is not the intention that the ship will leave this port again as a seagoing vessel and we will be officially informed about it in the very near future.
