Proposed Classification.

IT IS SUBMITTED the New York Office be informed that the contents of their letter of the 28th September and of the San Francisco Surveyor's letter of the 23rd September have been noted and, in the circumstances, the arrangements shown on the diagrammatic plan of General Pumping Arrangement are in order.

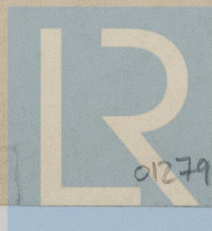
With reference to the question of the submission of plans for vessels coming into classification, it should be pointed out that in order to give proper consideration as to the suitability of the vessel for class with this Society, the plans detailed in Section 4 of the Rules for Periodical Surveys (Page 25) should be submitted at an early stage of the survey, so that any essential alterations could be carried out during the survey. Otherwise, considerable annoyance, expense and trouble to the Owners might be caused by a subsequent request for alterations when the vessel has resumed service, and in some cases the classification withheld until the alterations had been completed.

If detailed plans are not available, outline plans should be prepared showing the essential details and, if necessary, be supplemented by the Surveyor's observations.
