Nature of Survey Special Survey for Classification ~~and~~ Complete.

This vessel was built in 1940 under the Survey of the American Bureau of Shipping. Before entering service as a cargo ship she was converted, for war service, to an Aircraft Carrier.

The vessel has now been reinstated as a cargo ship, and classification with this Society is desired.

The equipment of anchors and chain cables on board complies with the Rules except as regards the weights of the bower anchors which are considerably in excess of those prescribed by the Rules. It is submitted, however, as in other vessels of this type they be accepted, and as the equipment has been tested by the American Bureau the Figure '1' be assigned, but the Notation "Lloyd's A & CP" be omitted.

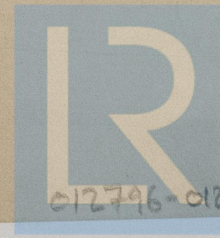
