CLASSING LETTER.

10185 "OKHOTSK" - This ship has today been classed + local "Ice Class 3" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

I shall be glad if you will endorse the enclosed Certificates for shafting and piston rods as having been examined in the finished condition.

Please forward Certificates for the spare screw-shaft and electric motors for essential pumps, except lubricating oil pumps.

10788 "JESSIE MAERSK" - As recommended and subject as previously recorded.

10806 "GULF SCOT" - As recommended, except that the class has now been continued subject, inter alia, to the six superheater tubes in the port Boiler now plugged being dealt with at the next Main Boiler Survey.

"NORTH PRINCESS" Reverting to my Classing Letters of the 9th July and 7th August, I shall be glad if you will forward a plan of the additional diesel oil service tank for the diesel generator engine which was installed at your Port during May last.
