on 8 th March 1963 and the following alterations to the conditions of

assignment of loadlines have now been ~~effected~~ found:—

The tonnage hatch is provided with two-part steel cover with joint, secured from below by hook screwed bolts spaced less than 24 inches.

The tonnage hatch scuppers blanked off efficiently.

The Load - lines appropriate to the Closed Shelter Deck condition, were marked by punching, painted and verified, and previous marks obliterated.

The tonnage opening ~~qqe~~ in the tonnage hatch bulkhead and in tweendeck bulkheads are closed by jointed steel plates and bolted with screws spaced not more than 12 inches apart.

The Vessel has been converted ~~e~~ to the Closed Shelter Deck Condition.
