This ship was built by Port Arthur S.B.Co.Ltd., Port Arthur, Ontario in 1945 and then classed 100A1 "With freeboard" "For China Coastal and River Service".

The class was expunged from the Register Book for non-compliance with the Rules 3.7.52.

In a cable received 3.8.60 the Yokohama Surveyors state that the new Owners are interested in Reclassification.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the Owners be advised, through the Yokohama Surveyors, that for Reclassification it will be necessary for:-

1. The requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY (C) to be complied with including the drilling of the structure in such parts where signs of wastage are evident.
2. Any major repairs which have been or are to be effected to the structure since the ship's class was expunged to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and confirm that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules.
3. Structural alterations affecting the longitudinal and/or transverse strength of the ship which may be required at this time should be carried out in accordance with plans to be previously approved.
4. Structural alterations which may have been carried out since the ship's class was expunged and which affect the longitudinal and transverse strength of the ship and Register Book particulars to be reported, and
5. full particulars of the equipment on board, including weights, tests and condition of anchors also length, diameter, tests and condition etc. of chain cable to be furnished for consideration.
