Just prior to the completion of this vessel, the Owners decided to have arrangements made for carrying vegetable oil in the forward deep tank.

The scantlings of the centre line bulkhead, however, were found to be inadequate for this purpose, and the Surveyors state, the increased stiffening will be effected on the vessel's return from her Maiden Voyage.

The Notation "Carrying vegetable oil in forward deep tank", to be WITHHELD until the centre line bulkhead of this tank is suitably stiffened.
