In reply to London classing letter dated 26th August, 1959 we have to report that at the time of survey it was stated by the Owner's Representative that the boilers are being used for domestic heating purposes only and that a maximum working pressure of 65 p.s.i. would not be exceeded.

It is submitted that if the maximum boiler pressure of 200 p.s.i. is later requested it would be advisable to recommend the steam pipes be gauged and tested in accordance with the Rule requirements.
