EXAMINATION ~~OF THE HOLD~~ AS PER ORDER OF No. 2 hold.

At the request of the Owner's Representative, an examination was made in No. 2 hold for possible leakage. It was stated that a previous survey had been held in Tocopilla, Chile in February, 1959 when the hold was in a partly loaded condition, approximately two tons of cargo had been damaged by water. The findings of the surveyor were damages caused by sweating of all inside steel works.

Now done: No. 2 hold examined after cargo had been discharged and no leakage found.
