Dear Sir,

We have to confirm our telegram of to-day's date reading :

NIKOBAR, SEWAMPURE, TRANQUEBAR OWNERS AGREE ADVANCING CLASS-  
IFICATION NOW AS FAR AS POSSIBLE.

As stated in our letter of the 3rd instant we have to-day had a conference with the Owners, on which occasion the whole question of transferring the above 3 ships to this Society's class was discussed. The Owners are agreeable to continue the classification commenced at Baltimore and they are now going to send the necessary instructions to their representative at Kiel. The tank-testing may eventually cause some difficulty on account of oily water and it has therefore been promised the Owners that the testing might be done in stages to suit the Owners' convenience.
